



Snowbound Block Ten



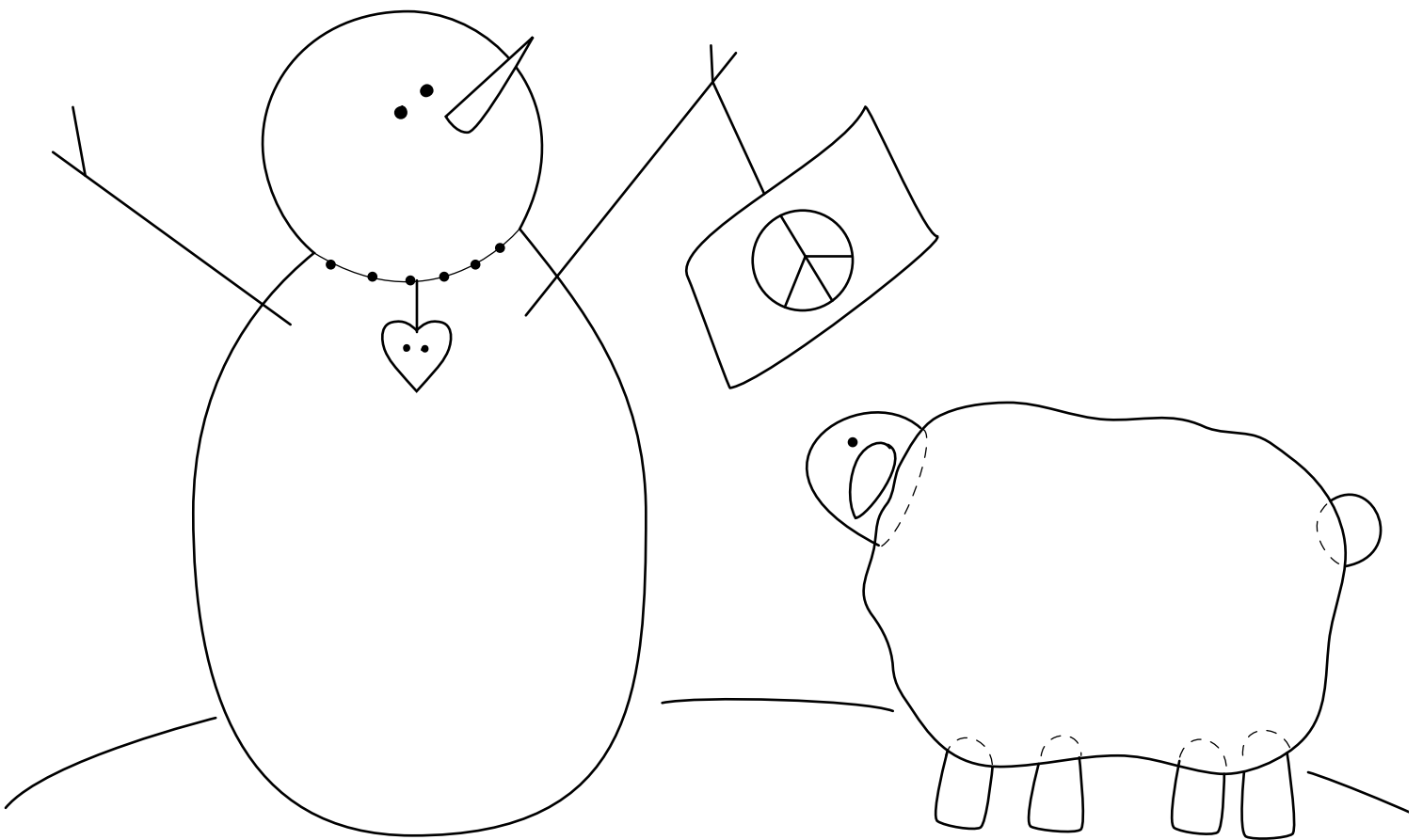
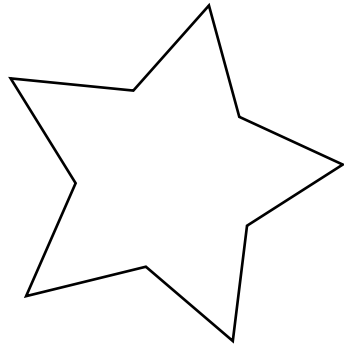
APPLIQUÉ:

- Cut appliqué background square 9 ½" x 9 ½". (You may want to cut a bit larger and trim to size after appliqué is complete.)
- Prepare appliqué using your favorite method. Using a fabric pencil or water erasable marker, mark peace symbol on peace sign. Mark snowman's eyes, nose, necklace and arm.
- Place finished bottom of snowman and lamb legs 1" up from bottom raw edge of background fabric.
- Appliqué snowman, peace sign, star, and lamb in place following pattern.

EMBROIDERY:

- Place the background and pattern right side up over a light box or bright window. Trace snowman's arms and snow line onto background with a fabric pencil or water erasable marker.
- Arms: Chain stitch, DMC #300 brown or dark brown of choice, 2 strands.
- Snowman and lamb eyes: French knots, DMC #310 black, 2 strands. Wrap floss around needle 3 times.
- Nose: Outline with tiny back stitch, fill in with satin stitch, lengthwise, DMC #3776 orange, 2 strands.
- Necklace: Tiny stem stitch, DMC #3787 gray, 2 strands.
- Peace sign & string: Tiny stem stitch, DMC #3787 gray, 2 strands
- Snow line: Tiny stem stitch, DMC blanc, 3 strands.
- After quilting is complete sew a ½" red heart button to necklace. Sew six gold seed beads to necklace.

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Place finished bottom of snowman and lamb legs 1" up from bottom raw edge of background fabric.
