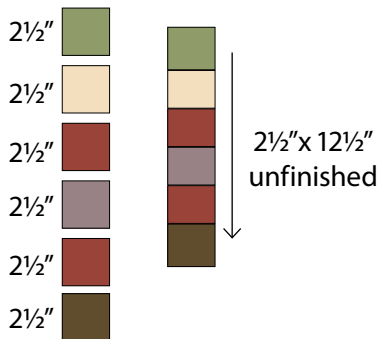
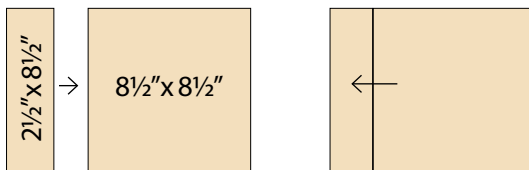


## Block 3 construction

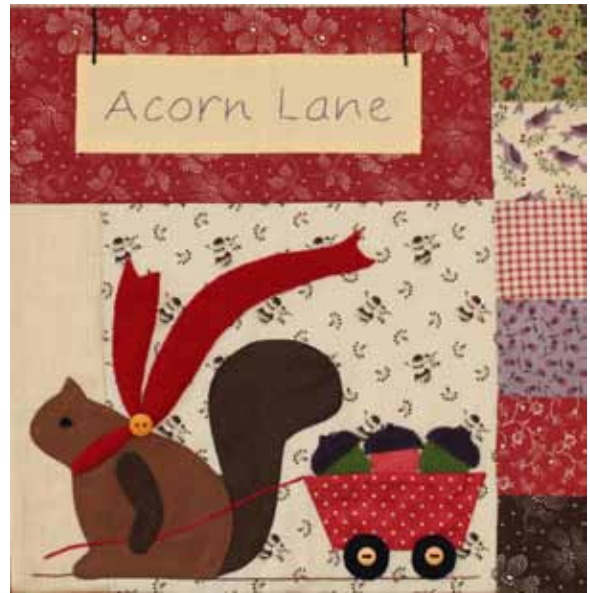
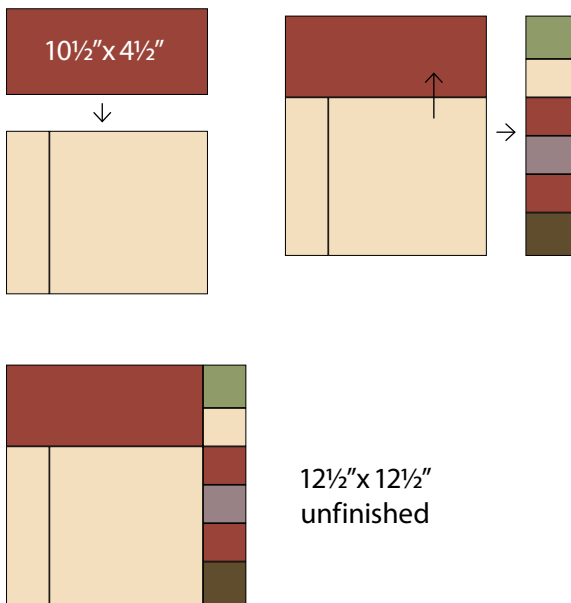
(A) Combine (6)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.



(B) Join (1)  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square and (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.



(C) Add (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Add the previous  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square unit.

## Appliqué

- Prepare squirrel and cart using your favorite method of appliqué. Before you appliqué the squirrel, place pattern right side up over a light box or bright window. Trace the squirrel's eye and rope line onto squirrel's body and tail using a fabric pencil or water erasable marker.
- Appliqué squirrel placing finished bottom of squirrel  $\frac{1}{2}$ " up from bottom raw edge of block.
- Prepare acorns, wheels and squirrel's scarf using your favorite method of appliqué. If using wool, trace the patterns onto dull side of freezer paper. Cut freezer paper  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from traced line. Iron shiny side of freezer paper to wool and cut out directly on traced line.
- Place the pattern and block right side up over a light box or bright window. Pin scarf, acorn, cart and wheels in place following pattern. Trace rope and ground lines onto background with a fabric pencil or water erasable marker. Follow directions under embroidery to appliqué the wool scarf and acorns.
- Prepare sign using your favorite method of appliqué. Before you appliqué the sign, trace the wording onto sign using a fabric pencil or water erasable marker. Appliqué sign following pattern placing finished top of sign  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " down from top raw edge of block. Trace chain onto background/sign. Embroider words and chain following directions under embroidery.

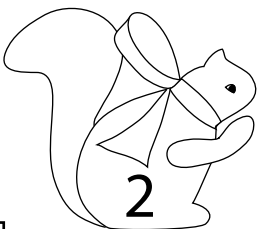

# Acorn Lane

### Continued

#### **Embroidery \*\*all embroidery uses 2 strands of floss\*\***

- Wool scarf: Whip stitch, Cosmo #4300 or DMC #816 red.
- Wool acorns: Whip stitch, Cosmo #633 or DMC #3346 apple green, Cosmo #814 or DMC #961 pink and Cosmo #556 or DMC #791 purple.
- Wool wheels: Whip stitch, Cosmo #600 or DMC #310 black.
- Squirrel's eye: Outline with a tiny stem stitch and fill in with a satin stitch, Cosmo #600 or DMC #310 black.
- Rope line: Tiny chain stitch using two strands floss, Cosmo #4300 or DMC #816 red.
- Words on sign: Back stitch using two strands floss, Cosmo #556 or DMC #791 purple.
- Hanging chain for sign: Tiny stem stitch, Cosmo #600 or DMC #310 black.
- Ground line: Tiny stem stitch, Cosmo #310 or DMC #869 brown.
- After quilting is complete sew a 3/8" light gold button to the center of each wheel. Sew a 7/16" dark gold button to scarf as shown in picture.
