



Snowbound, Block Two

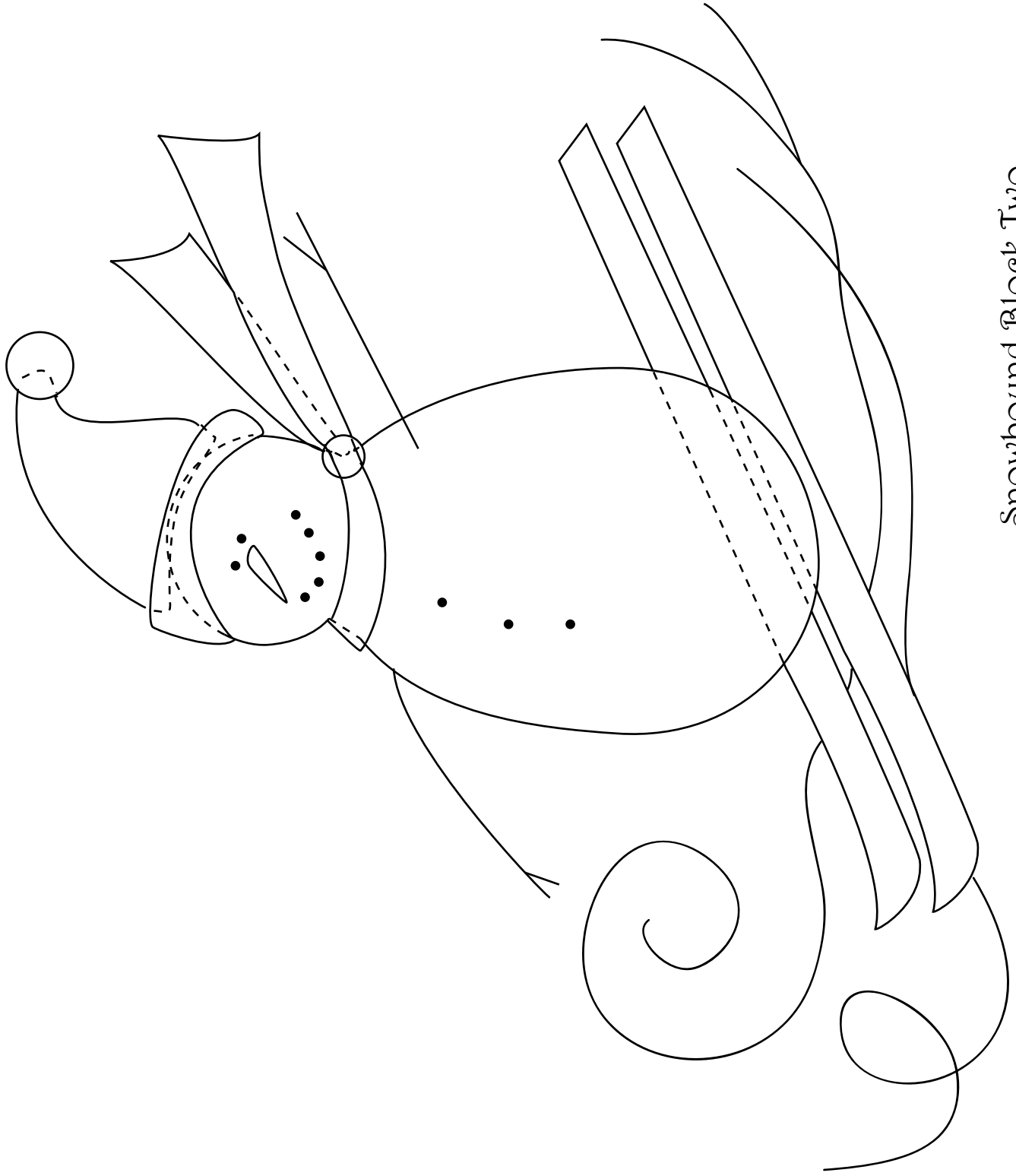


APPLIQUÉ

- Cut appliqué background square 9 ½" x 9 ½".
- Prepare appliqué using your favorite method. Remember the patterns have NOT been reversed for fusible web appliqué.
- Mark eyes, nose and button placement with a fabric pencil or water erasable marker, before you appliqué snowman in place.
- Center appliqué on background fabric. Make sure the front end of bottom ski is ¾" up from bottom raw edge of background fabric.
- Appliqué snowman, hat, scarf and skis in place using your favorite method of appliqué.

EMBROIDERY

- Place the background and pattern, right side up over a light box, or bright window. Trace the snowman's arms, and snow flurries onto the background fabric with a fabric pencil, or a water erasable marker.
- Using two strands of DMC #300 brown, or dark brown of choice, chain stitch snowman's arms.
- Using two strands of DMC #310 black, embroider eyes and mouth with French knots. Wrap floss around needle 3 times.
- Using two strands of DMC # 3375 orange, outline nose with a tiny back stitch and fill in with a lengthwise satin stitch.
- Using three strands of DMC white (blanc), embroider snow flurries with a tiny stem stitch.
- After quilting is complete, sew a ⅜" red button to snowman's scarf, and a small gold star button to top of hat.
