CUTTING

Background

(4) 10 ½" x wof strips, sub cut into
 (12) 10 ½" squares, trim to 9 ½" after
 appliqué is complete

Red (chain blocks)

(9) 1 ½" x wof strips

White/blue (chain blocks)

(3) 1 ½" x wof strips
 (2) 5 ½" w wof strips

White/red (chain blocks)

(2) 3 ½" x wof strips
 (2) 7 ½" x wof strips

Inner border

(5) 1 ½" x wof strips, pieced into
 (2) 1 ½" x 45 ½" pieces
 (2) 1 ½" x 47 ½" pieces

Outer border

(6) 5" x wof strips, pieced into
 (2) 5" x 47 ½" pieces
 (2) 5" x 56 ½" pieces

Binding

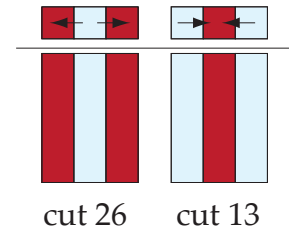
(6) 2 ¼" x wof strips, pieced end to end

CHAIN BLOCK

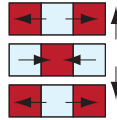
CENTER NINE-PATCH

Use: (3) 1 1/2" red strips and (3) white/blue 1 1/2" strips

- Sew a red strip to each side of a white/blue strip.
- Sew a white/blue stripe to each side of a red strip.
- Subcut into 1 1/2" sections. You will need (26) from the red/blue/red strips and (13) blue/red/blue strips. Sew into a nine patch as in the diagram below. Press in the direction of the arrows.



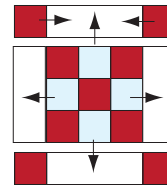
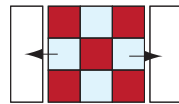
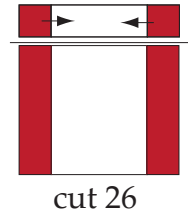
Make 13.



FIRST ROUND

Use: (2) 1 1/2" red strips and (2) white/red 3 1/2" strips

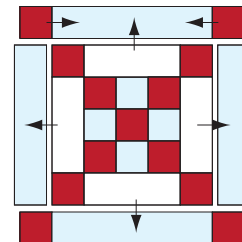
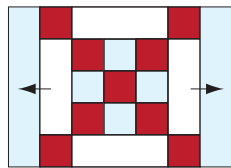
- Sew a red strip to each side of one of the 3 1/2" white/red strips.
- Press toward the white/red strip. Sub cut into (26) 1 1/2" sections.
- From remaining white/red strip, cut (26) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.
- Sew a 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle to each side of the center 9-patch. Press away from the center.
- Next, add the pieced strips to the top and bottom. Press away from the center.



SECOND ROUND

Use: (2) 1 1/2" red strips and (2) white/blue 5 1/2" strips

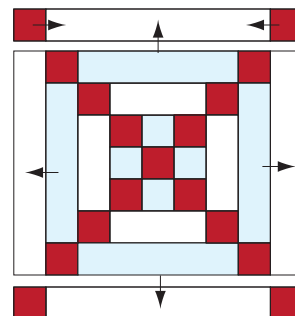
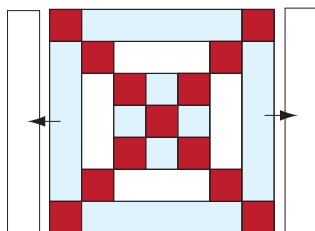
- Sew a red strip to each side of one white/blue 5 1/2" strip. Subcut into (26) 1 1/2" sections.
- From remaining white/blue strip, cut (26) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. Add to center, as you did for round one.



THIRD ROUND

Use: (2) 1 1/2" red strips and (2) white/red 7 1/2" strips

- Sew a red strip to each side of one white/red 7 1/2" strip. Subcut into (26) 1 1/2" sections.
- From remaining white/red strip, cut (26) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles. Again, add to the center in the same manner.



The block will measure 9 1/2" unfinished.

Make 13 chain blocks.

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After appliqué or stitchery blocks are complete, sew the blocks into five rows of five blocks each. Press toward the chain blocks. Sew the rows together.

INNER BORDER

Sew a 1 ½" x 45 ½" strip to each side of the quilt top. Press toward the border.

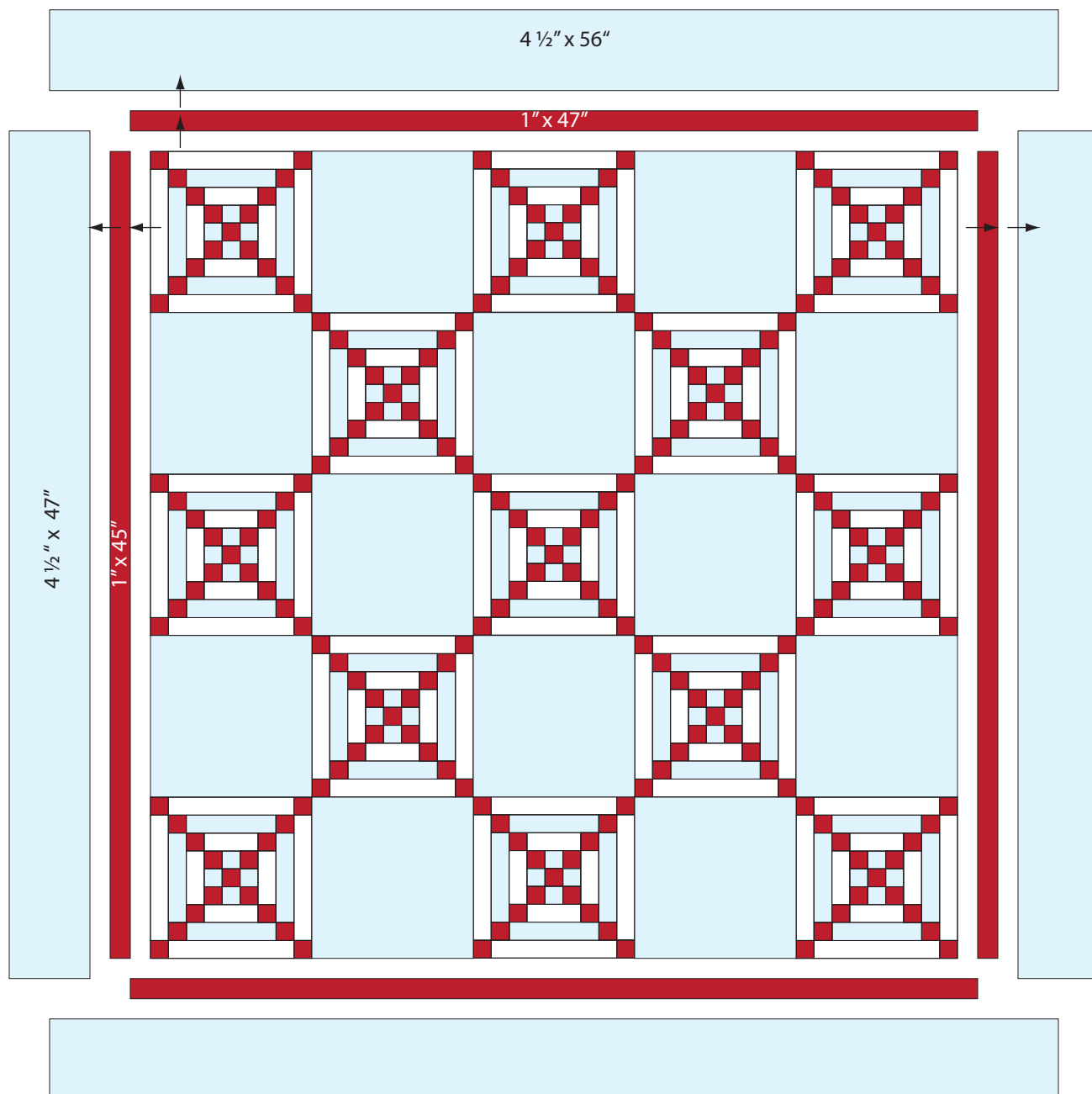
Sew a 1 ½" x 47 ½" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press toward the border.

OUTER BORDER

Sew a 5" x 47 ½" strip to each side of the quilt top. Press toward the border.

Sew a 5" x 56 ½" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press toward the border.

Layer, baste and quilt. Bind and you have a beautiful snowman quilt for the holidays!
